




Their Excellencies, approaching the end of their term as Baron and Baroness of Dun Carraig, have expressed the desire to continue to serve the Barony and the Kingdom for a second term. With the consent of the Their Majesties and in accordance with Kingdom law, a Polling of Confidence shall be conducted by the Heirs so as to receive the thoughts and advice of the Populace regarding this matter.

Please note that to participate in the polling one must be a paid member of the SCA, and all members of the Populace are encouraged to review their membership and ensure that they are paid in full. 
Will be movement on coronets & herald tabards. No updates on ADITME.

## Officer Reports

### B & B's Report

June: Congratulations to Lady Naila, the newest Pearl in Atlantia. Dun Carraig had really good participation in Ruby Joust, Highland River Melees. Planning to attend University, Nine Realms, King's Assessment, Pennsic, and Baron will attend Novice (Baroness has a conflict). Baron has an idea for the finials on pavilion uprights - get someone to make bottony crosses instead of acorns (populace liked this idea). At some point, will send out query on who will be fighting at Pennsic (for tabards).

July:(via Seneschal): Planning to hold a short court at Pennsic, August 4, 7 PM. Please come. Please submit award recommendations, both for Baronial awards and Kingdom awards. Any questions about making recommendation process, ask on Facebook or contact the Herald.

### Seneschal's Report

June: Arranging to check shed. Working on Baronial polling of confidence. Encourage all paid members to change polling default from paper to electronic, for economy and convenience. This is a yes/no polling (for continuation of Harald and Ceridwen in office) - no commentary.

Naila's Pearl was for cooking, brewing, sewing, illuminations, etc.

Some offers of poetry, essays, recipes - all are welcome, and more.




