Old Business:

Archery event - going OK. Troll will be opening earlier than 9, letting people on

Emergency committee - does decision need to be ratified later by non-emergency committee, or leave as is? Add to policy that emergency committee decision is final. Troll - leave as is. Exchequer's Report

- 1) Congratulations to Their Excellencies, now Their Highnesses!
- 2) Registry balance was \$6101.81 as of 04/07/13.
- 3) Quarterly Report for Jan-Feb-March submitted to MD Regional 8: confirmed as received in April.
- 4) Royal Archery Tournament on May 18 (weekend after next) features "Ransom the Cure" charity collection. Per direction of Kingdom Exchequer:
 - a. All "Ransom the Cure" monies, cash and check, to be collected and tracked at event by MOL
 - b. "Ransom the Cure" monies will be kept SEPARATE from any MOL fees collected
 - c. All checks to be made out to "SCA-MD, Barony of Dun Carraig."
 - d. MOL transfers all "Ransom the Cure" monies collected to Baronial exchequer, who deposits them as one distinct deposit (i.e., not combined with any other deposits) for tracking purposes
- e. After the event, Baronial Exchequer forwards "Ransom the Cure" monies in one check from "SCA-MD, Barony of Dun Carraig" to "SCA-Kingdom of Atlantia."
- 5) Baronial Financial Policy: I have had no word from Kingdom yet.
 - a. If Kingdom approves, Policy takes effect
 - b. Policy published in newsletter for two months running (once approved)
- 6) Having sitting Royalty in the Barony presents our group with special financial challenges and opportunities, due to the fact that our events will draw more people:
 - a. More expenses/other resource draws:
 - i. Plan for more port-o-cans
 - ii. Plan for bigger feasts
 - iii. More help needed at Troll to process attendees in.
 - b. More opportunities for revenue generation
 - i. Drawings
 - ii. Silent auctions
 - iii. Suggest as prizes/auction items: one or two painted wall-hangings like those made for Sutton Hootenanny (relatively inexpensive, may still have some leftover materials, very splashy and spectacular will draw lots of interest on display).

Process for Officer Replacement/Selection

- Upon reaching their decision to step down from their position, a Baronial Officer shall provide written notice of their intent to the Baronial Seneschal and sitting Baronage.
- o A minimum notice of two weeks is requested, but is not required.
- · Upon receipt of notice, the Baronial Seneschal shall announce the open position to the Baronial Populace via the Baronial electronic mailing list or forum, and at the next Baronial Meeting.
- o Those persons interested in filling the open Officer's position shall inform the Seneschal of their interest, either verbally or via written correspondence.
- o The time frame for accepting volunteers shall be no less than 5 days, and the closing date to accept volunteers shall be clearly given.
- · Upon the closing date, the Seneschal shall provide the list of all volunteers for the open Baronial Officer's position to the Sitting Baronage and (if available) the Officer to be replaced.
- · Once the list of all volunteers has been presented to the sitting Baronage, they shall be announced to the Baronial Populace via the Baronial electronic mailing list or forum, and at the next Baronial Meeting. o The Baronial Populace shall be invited to privately offer commentary to the Seneschal and sitting Baronage.
- o The time frame for commentary shall be no less than 5 days, and the closing date for comments regarding the volunteers shall be clearly given.
- · The sitting Baronage, after consulting with Seneschal and (if available) the Officer to be replaced, having reviewed all comments from the Baronial Populace, shall select the replacement Officer.

 o This replacement Officer shall be announced to the Baronial Populace via the Baronial electronic mailing list or forum, and at the next Baronial Meeting.
- · The replacement Officer will work with the Seneschal and sitting Baronage to complete any and all Kingdom warranting processes required of their position.
- o Should the replacement Officer be unable to receive their warrant from the Kingdom, the sitting Baronage may select another candidate from the list of volunteers, or should no other volunteers be available, request the Seneschal begin the process again.
- · Should an unforeseen situation occur where an officer need be replaced immediately in order to allow the Barony and its interests to function, the sitting Baronage, having consulted with both the Kingdom Seneschal and Kingdom Officer for the position to be filled, and having their consent, may immediately appoint a person of their choosing to the vacant office.
- o The officer shall serve no more than 6 months at the latest, unless the officer places his/her name on the volunteer list once the above process is conducted to select a new officer.
- o As soon as is feasible, a replacement Officer shall be selected using the above process.
