

Chronicler's Choice

Self-instructor in the art of hair work, dressing hair, making curls, switches, braids, and hair jewelry of every description.

Published 1867. This is a 19th-century do-it-yourself instruction book for the fad of jewelry made from human hair. The hair-braiding technique is very similar to kumihimo, and provides many interesting braiding patterns. There is also a section on weaving hair for wigs & artificial curls, and how to do some fancy lady's hairdressing. SCAdians could adapt the techniques for styles of our period.

To quote a reviewer: All the histories of Kumihimo (a Japanese technique of braiding now very popular in the West) say that Kumihimo was first brought to the West in the mid-20th century by Japanese teachers who were initially very reluctant to share their art with non-Japanese students. This book would appear to give the lie to that. The diagrams are clearly kumihimo or closely related, and the socalled 'braiding board' is exactly like a marudai. However PLEASE NOTE that the PDF copy of this book is missing quite a few pages and a lot of illustrations. [so read it online instead of downloading the PDF - chron.]
