

For those who wish to study up for the November 11 Baronial Birthday's "Fantastic beasts and where to hunt them," here is a selection of near-period bestiaries.

The history of brutes, or, A description of living creatures : wherein the nature and properties of four-footed beasts are at large described

by Franz, Wolfgang, 1564-1628. First published 1612, this edition published 1672. https://archive.org/details/historyofbruteso00fran

My favorite part of this book is the discussion of whether unicorns exist, and whether they are the same or different from a rhinoceros. The author concludes that the unicorn must exist because it is mentioned in the Bible, and also because the authority Julius Caesar Sealinger had a friend who saw one once. And the Rhinoceros is a different animal because Julius Caesar Sealinger says so, and it is reported to have two horns instead of one.




