**From Sir Jonathas, Web Minister for Special Projects:**

Greetings All!

This fall Dun Carraig will need to conduct a polling for our Baronage. Recently the SCA has allowed Atlantia to begin conducting Baronial Pollings electronically, this is the same tool that is being used for all of the Polling Orders. However, each member needs to specifically request the electronic ballot instead of the traditional paper ballot. Each paper ballot costs the Barony just under \$2 per member which adds up quickly across all of our members. Plus the electronic ballots are much easier for the Royalty to manage when they have several other Baronial and Order Pollings all running at the same time.

So, how do you request to receive the electronic polling?

- 1) You need to sign up for an Atlantian Enterprise Login (AEL) account, this is the same account used to sign up for Atlantian University Classes, or to submit Award Recommendations if you already have one for those purposes. You can create an account at the polling website if you do not already have one.
- 2) Once you have logged on with your account, switch over to the Baronial Polling side of the polling site (second option on the left hand menu), note you should see the Baronial Heraldry images at the top of the page. Once on the Baronial side, if you see a big red and yellow error message, then your Membership is not yet linked with your Account, please fill out and submit the information requested within the error. That will allow the Web Minister to link them correctly. If you do not have this error then your Membership and Account are already linked and you can skip to the next step.
- 3) On the Baronial side of the polling website, click on the menu option "Baronial Ballot Type", it will show you which type of ballot you will currently receive, paper or electronic. Click on the ballot type to switch which one you will receive. The default is "Paper" as you must choose to receive the electronic ballot after you have an account. You will not be able to switch ballot types within seven days of the polling opening or while the polling is running, so please update your preference early.

Yes, this is available for all Baronies to use. Plus members of any Barony may go link their memberships and update their ballot preferences right now even when there is no polling scheduled yet for your Barony, it will just be sitting there already done when a polling does come around.

*Note from the Chronicler: "Baronial Polling" is the process by which the King & Queen of Atlantia periodically get opinions from the populace of a barony, on whether their current Baron and Baroness should remain in office, or, on who should be chosen when there are multiple candidates for a new Baron and Baroness. The decision is ultimately made by the Royals, but they desire the insight & advice of the baronial populace.*

 In attendance: Christopher, Valdr, Caitilin, Alexina, Adriana, Matthew, Alysa, Isolde, Mary, Richard, Jackie


Business Meetings are held on the first Tuesday of each month, 7:00pm at Big Larry's Comic Book Cafe, Leonardtown, MD 20650.

### Knight Marshal's Report


(via Seneschal & Caitilin) Working with Caitilin for rapier melee. Had new person, via Storvik & Awesomecon.




FIG. 47. A, Pommel; B, Grip; C, Knuckle-bow; D, D, Quillons; E, Counter-guard; F, Pas d'ane; G, Ricasso; H, Blade.





