

March Business Meeting

Old Business

Site surveys for upcoming events (done by Alexina, Ceridwen, Marguerite):

St Mary's College (Ceridwen) - \$500 for large area by Schaefer Hall. Put in crown bid, but Elkenburg was chosen. Historic St Mary's City has built a pavilion by the courthouse - Ceridwen can look into this.

Camp St. Charles in Newburg - willing to work with us on kitchen. \$100 per person or \$14,000 for entire camp.

Lions Camp Merrick - fee depends on what building you use. There are beds for 112 in cabins, dining for 180, massive kitchens. Use of all of site \$7,000; just kitchen, dining, rec hall, bath house \$900 per day. Might be day fee on top, cabins individually priced. Works out to about \$20 site fee, \$25 cabin, \$15 camping for a coronation.

American Legion - archery, field split fot parking & fighting. Nice kitchen. \$1400. Both American Legion & Camp Merrick are available 12/9, Legion might also be available 10/28.

For 80 people, estimeate Merrick \$20 a head, \$30 cabin; Legion \$15 a head.

New business

Possible class on basket weaving - Class costs \$60, materials \$40 (*my notes are not clear if materials are included or in addition to class fee*) for example Colonial Market basket, group receives \$20 per person. Teacher needs 6-20 people per class, room with access to water, tables that can get wet & can be walked around. Teacher would love to stay at somebody's house overnight, and maybe gas money. Discussed doing as a standalone class, or adjunct to University. Populace was interested.

B & B's Report

[Baroness Ceridwen ferch Owain, Baron Harald Brandarm Olafssen] Letters of Intent for next B&B are due the end of March.

Seneschal's Report

[Marguerite de Lyon]

Lusby community center wants payment for indoor fighter practice space starting in April: \$25/night for large room, \$10/night for small room if reserved by Calvert County residents. For free use, could register as a volunteer class - there may be insurance issues, need 1 - 2 background checks, would not go on schedule till fall. This comes to about \$1750 per year, with payment due quarterly. Fighters are willing to pass the hat at practices. Storvik asks fighters for \$2 apiece per practice, Lochmenre puts out a bucket for donations. Rose will do sign-up, as county resident. Motion was made to pay for 1 quarter (3 months) - populace vote approved the motion. Motion was made to pursue the volunteer class path, with 1-2 people as teachers with background checks and possible additional insurance - populace vote approved this motion too.

Reminder, quarterly reports are coming due.

Warrant request submitted. Demos on March 18 & 26.

Discussed demo policies:

- SCA and kingdom demo policy forbid hitting anybody who hasn't signed a waiver, even with a boffer. Fighting demos will be authorized fighters only. Neither kingdom or SCA policy prohibit allowing the public to tryon armor, hold a sword or shield, or participate in lawn games.
- Children are not allowed to handle *any* items without a parent present and okaying it. Boffer gear needs to be tucked away to avoid previous issues of kids running off with boffers
- Selfies with fighters recommended over whack-a-knight

Cherry Blossom Festival

- -Recently received site map we're right in the middle of things, between the food court and the face painting.
- -Have marshals planning to attend, Marguerite will bring list corners for fighting demos
- -Baron Harald is bringing the baronial tent
- -Because of issues with kids running off with boffer equipment last year, any boffer weapons or armor should be tucked out of sight if they aren't being actively worn, carried, or shown off by an SCA youth fighter.
- -We did receive confirmation from the festival that replica firearms will *not* be permitted, even if they are non-fireable display pieces.
- -We're allowed to start set-up at 9:30, the demo runs from 12-4, and breakdown can't start until 4
- -Attendees should bring their own chairs & anything they want to show off.
- -No vehicles are allowed in the park area, so we'll need carts or wagons for the pavilion and tables. (Gators will be provided to shuttle stuff.)

- -Need banners and signage.
- -Past attendance how many flyers/business cards? (Lots)

Adenwald is not warranted yet, still needs to do the training.


