

We will also be hosting a "Most Courteous to their Consort" competition (to be decided by the Ladies of the Gallery). We will also be sponsoring a fun display: "A&S Projects that DIDN'T Work". Documentation is not required, but you must specify what the item was intended to be, what went wrong and what you learned from the experience. The A&S Officer will determine the winner and special consideration will be given to tragically humorous outcomes. Finally, Dun Carraig will be hosting an "Artists Pavillion" to allow space for artisans to get together and work on their projects. It will be a chance to meet & greet other artisans, additionally providing newer members an opportunity to watch artisans working at their craft and answering questions.


Jonathas & Amalia's House Beer & Cordial Brewing (Lord Michael von Schonsee)


