
The Financial Policy Committee and Charter Committee are still scheduled to meet.

Relay for Life/ACS:

The new site (Hallowing Point Park, moved from Calvert H.S.) is fabulous. \$380,000 was raised for the event, and more money will come in until August 31. Numbers from the baronial team are not in yet. Nobody entered the favor competition at the DC/ Storvik event, so the intended prize is now on ebay (Manesse Codex). All the money won from the auction will go to the ACS. Also, Phillip's employer, Oracle, is matching 100% of his donation of \$140, to total \$280 for his contribution to ACS. 


