

#### Proposal for changes in the Orders and Awards for Dun Carraig:

#### ORDERS:

- Order of the Seahawk Pre-eminent Order for the Barony. Granted to those who
  have proven themselves to be stalwarts of the Barony for supporting DC through
  their efforts in varied and diverse means
- Order of the Champions of Dun Carraig order for those who have served as
  baronial champions. Proposed name <u>Order of the Mastiffs of Dun Carraig</u> (in the
  spirit of a "high end" dog in the middle ages used for guarding individuals,
  households and as war dogs. They were also hunters.) Badge a red seadog's head
  erased? (the neck torn in three strips) wearing a gold collar from which a gold

Order of the (A&S) – on going excellence in the arts and sciences. Proposed name Order of the Red Flame (in the spirit of the symbol for our A&S officer, the lantern—the light of inspirations) polling?

- Order of the (Service) on going excellence in service. Proposed name <u>Order of the Path</u> (in the spirit of the following the path of the Dream) polling?
- Order of the (Marshaled Activities) on going excellence in marshaled activities.
   Proposed name <u>Order of the Silver Blade</u> (in the spirit of

combat)

Proposed name <u>Order of the Sword of Dun Carraig</u> (an inverted cross bottany fitchy) polling?

 Order of the (Missile Weapons – thrown, archery, siege) – on going excellence in missile weapons. Proposed names? polling?

#### A WARDS

- Mark of Excellence award given for specific achievement or action within the barony.
- Award for A&S given for a specific A&S achievement. Proposed name ??
   Proposed bead color green (color of the laurel leaf)
- Award for Service given for a specific service or action. Proposed name ??
   Proposed bead color red (color of blood shed by the pelican)
- Award for Marshaled given for a specific armoured/rapier achievement or action. Proposed name ??

Proposed bead color – white (color of a knight's belt)

• Award for Missile Weapons – given for a specific missile weapon achievement or action. (target or combat archery, thrown weapons, siege)
Proposed name - ?? Proposed bead color – yellow (color of the sun, from where the missiles drop)

The idea here is to create an award structure much like the Award of Arms, in that each discipline has its own award, and carries with it a Mark of Excellence, just like an Opal carries with it an Award of Arms for example. The first time a person receives any of these awards they will receive a MoE and the cross bottony token that goes with it, as well as the bead that represents that award. With each successive award they will only receive the bead.

 Baroness's Award of Courtesy – awarded to an individual who has demonstrated exceptional courtesy to others.

Questions for immediate consideration. Voting will be at the August meeting. Names and bead colors will not be decided until a later date.

- I. Approval of the general structure? (Most at the meeting approved.)
- 2. Do we want to keep the Order of the Champions of Dun Carraig?

#### Opinions at the meeting:

- (-) The order is redundant. When a champion steps down, they receive a rose, or some other token that they have served as champion.
- (-) The order serves no purpose and tracking of champions could be simply a list maintained on the web page.
- (+) The order gives a formal recognition and listing of those who have served as champion. Names disappear after several years and coming up with a list of prior champions was difficult.
- (+) Symbology (tokens) allows others to recognize gentles as having served as champion in an area.
- 3. Do we want to keep 4 New Orders/MoE (A&S, Service, Marshaled (Heavy and Rapier), and Missile Weapons (Thrown weapons, Archery, Siege)?

#### Opinions at the meeting:

- (-) Simplicity combine all Marshaled activities.
- (-) Combining the orders makes it easier for one to earn all of the orders, or Marks of Excellence. For example, limited females would achieve the heavy/rapier only order.
- (+) On a kingdom level, missile weapons are separated and awarded separately.
- (+) There is a distinct difference between the heavy / light fighters and missile weapons.
- 4. Do we want to make the new orders (excluding the champions and seahawk) polling?

#### Opinions at the meeting: (General opinion was NO.)

- (-) Polling orders take a lot more maintenance. Even though they will be small in comparison with orders like that of the Laurel, it is still probable that people will argue.
- (x) Opinion that either all 3 or 4 orders should be polling , or not polling do not make some polling and others not.
- (+) The people who have the expertise in e.g. fighting should decide who is worthy of their order. The baron / baroness are often not familiar with what people have achieved, and recommendations for awards have been low.

Names and bead colors for the Mark will be decided at a later date. However, feel free to send your suggestions to Amalia, who will keep a running list – making it easier for when we do make a decision. Please include your rational for your choices – see suggestions already listed.

- Dun Carraig's court will be Thursday night with Ponte Alto at Pennsic.




